



Pre-Conference Doctoral Student Workshop: Labour Law in European and Global Perspectives 14.30 – 18.30 Wednesday 18 May 2016 at Stockholm University

On 19 – 20 May 2016 the research program *Regulating Markets and Labour – Nordic, European and Global Perspectives*, ReMarkLab, will arrange an international conference with the title “New Foundations of Labour Law in the Globalised Market Economy?”

A pre-conference workshop for doctoral students will take place the day before the opening of the conference. ReMarkLab and the Institute for Social Private Law at Stockholm University have the great pleasure of inviting doctoral students working with European or global aspects on labour and employment law in a broad sense to participate in the workshop. To participate, please send no more than 3 pages with a short abstract of your doctoral project and a specific question that you want to discuss. Send your contribution to marit.wedin@juridicum.su.se not later than 1 February 2016. Please note that the number of participants is limited. Decisions of acceptance will be communicated by 4 March 2016.
